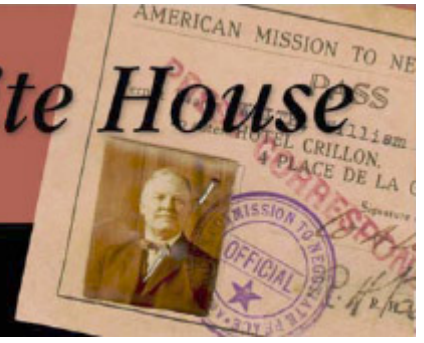

- William Allen White Day at the University of Kansas (near his birthday, February 10)
