HERITAGE TRUST FUND GRANT WORKSHOP SCHEDULED FOR GARDEN CITY

TOPEKA, KS—The Kansas Historical Society announced it will host a Heritage Trust Fund Grant Workshop at 9:30 a.m. Tuesday, November 6 at the Finney County Museum, 403 South 4th Street (at the entrance to Lee Richardson Zoo), Garden City. There is no cost involved, but advance registration is encouraged. Registrations may be made by calling 785-272-8681, extension 245.

The Heritage Trust Fund is a state program that provides matching funds for the preservation of properties listed on the National Register of Historic Places or the Register of Historic Kansas Places. This is a competitive grant program, in which applicants compete for the funds that are available for that year. The deadline for applications for the 2008 round of grants will be March 1, 2008. The deadline for the preliminary application for staff review is January 15, 2008. Applications will be available at the Garden City HTF Grant Workshop.
