## **GHOSTS OF FORT HAYS TO SHARE THEIR STORIES WITH VISITORS** *at Fort Hays State Historic Site, October 29, 2008*

**HAYS, Kan.**—Many in the Hays area know the legend of the Blue Light Lady but there are other, lesser known, stories of ghosts and spirits walking the grounds of the Fort Hays Historic Site. Get a chance to hear some of these stories during a special program Wednesday, October 29, 2008. Tour guides will escort small groups of visitors around the grounds where volunteer storytellers will relate some of the ghostly sightings and unexplained happenings that have occurred in the buildings and on the museum grounds over the years. Tours will leave from the visitor's center beginning at 7:30 p.m. and will leave every half hour until 9:30 p.m. There is a nominal charge of \$1 per person for the tour.
