## HISTORICAL SOCIETY ANNOUNCES WINTER SCHEDULE

TOPEKA, KS— Beginning December 1, 2008, most of the 16 state historic sites administered by the Kansas Historical Society will change to a winter schedule.

These sites will observe a 9:30 a.m. – 5 p.m. Thursday – Saturday schedule: Constitution Hall State Historic Site, Lecompton; Cottonwood Ranch State Historic Site, Studley; Grinter Place State Historic Site, Kansas City; Hollenberg Pony Express Station State Historic Site, near Hanover; Kaw Mission State Historic Site, Council Grove; Mine Creek Battlefield State Historic Site, near Pleasanton; Pawnee Indian Museum State Historic Site, near Republic; Shawnee Indian Mission State Historic Site, Fairway; and William Allen White House State Historic Site, Emporia.

A few sites are open year round with the following schedules: Fort Hays State Historic Site, Hays, 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. Tuesday – Saturday; Goodnow House State Historic Site, Manhattan, 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. Tuesday – Friday, 2 – 5 p.m. Saturday – Sunday; John Brown Museum State Historic Site, Osawatomie, 10 a.m. – 5 p.m. Tuesday – Saturday, 1 – 5 p.m. Sunday; Marais des Cygnes Massacre State Historic Site, near Pleasanton; and Pawnee Rock State Historic Site, Pawnee Rock, dawn to dusk.
