INFORMATION FOR BUS DRIVERS

Over the next several years, the Kansas Capitol is undergoing a major renovation. Please be aware of the changes in and around the capitol grounds. These changes are necessary to ensure access and safety for everyone. This renovation will preserve the building for future generations. We appreciate your patience during this time. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to call us.

CHANGES TO THE ACCESS OF THE KANSAS CAPITOL

- 1) Public access is limited to the east side (Jackson Street, one way street heading north), ground level behind the stairs. Do not go up the stairs, you will not be able to enter through those doors.
- 2) Parking on and around the Capitol grounds is limited to authorized permit holders. All other vehicles, including buses, are not allowed.
- 3) Please view the enclosed Capitol Parking Map. This indicates where buses may park. If the cutback area is not available, buses may park at the state motor pool parking lot at First and Van Buren. Buses do not need permission to park at that location. Bus parking is no longer available at the Judicial Center parking lot or the Capitol Entrance.
 - a. Buses may unload just south of the intersection at Ninth and Jackson Streets. The safest place to unload is the far right lane on the east side of Jackson Street. This is so passengers may unload away from moving traffic. There is a stoplight and crosswalk there so passengers can safely cross Jackson at the light after unloading. It is strongly suggested that the group wait and cross all at once so as not to unnecessarily hold up traffic or cause an accident.
- 4) Please communicate with the adult chaperones about where to pick up your group. Groups may exit through the south or east side doors, but may only enter on the east side. There is no entering or exiting on the west or north sides of the Capitol.

Have a wonderful time enjoying the Capitol. The Capitol belongs to all Kansans. We welcome your visit. Please help us to preserve the Capitol for future generations. Thank you for your cooperation during our renovation.
