FIELD TRIP SCHOLARSHIP

TOUR INFORMATION

Theme Tours

Red Rocks State Historic Site offers three theme tours for school groups: Hats Off for elementary, Reform Era for middle school, and Writing Editorials for high school. Tours generally last around 90 minutes. A packet of information that will help teachers and students prepare for the tour will be provided.

Cost

Each themed school group tour costs \$6 per student. A regular group tour of the site for 10 or more students is \$2 per student. For every 10 students, one teacher/sponsor is admitted free. For adults outside of the 10 to 1 teacher/sponsor ratio, the price of admission is \$5. Bus drivers are admitted free.

Site Hours

Red Rocks will open for the 2019 season from Thursday, April 4, through Saturday, October 26. The site is open 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. Thursday through Saturday.

Booking the Tour

Tours need to be reserved at least two weeks in advance.

Scholarship Information

The William Allen White Community Partnership, Inc., is offering 10 scholarships of \$200 to help area schools fund field trips to Red Rocks. The scholarship money can be used for admission and transportation. Please note that schools **MUST PAY** for tour fees on the day of the field trip. A check for the amount of the scholarship will be sent to the school **AFTER** the field trip.

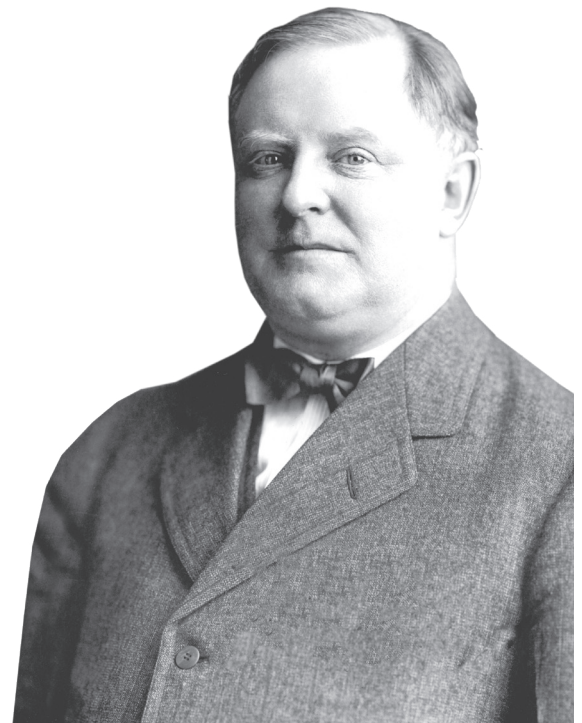
Applications will be accepted throughout the tourist season or until all 10 scholarships have been awarded.
