Description: The Presbyterian Church is a rectangular native stone structure with gable roof and wooden cupola over the main entrance. Since its construction in 1874 the church has been considerably altered, especially through the addition of a chancel and basement in 1930. The boundaries of the Register of Historic Kansas Places property
Significance: Built in 1874 of local stone, the Presbyterian Church is the oldest church in Marion and a notable example of early masonry work in Kansas.
